

Medical Assistant Sponsorship Program

Summary

PCMC is offering financial support paid directly to a school in exchange for the student’s full-time work commitment to PCMC. The sponsorship work agreements will be for 3 years, or 36 months once degree, certification and/or licensure are obtained. Sponsorships are tied to PCMC’s need for Medical Assistants in our Pipestone Family Clinic, Edgerton Family Clinic, or Pipestone Specialty Clinics.

Target Population

Individuals who are accepted into or attending a Medical Assistant Program at a local institution and are committed to working at PCMC.

Sponsorship and Work Commitment Details

PCMC will pay financial assistance directly to the candidate’s school that will be applied to full or partial expense of the student’s tuition and direct student expenses. Students are responsible for remaining balances and all expenses associated with daily living (Food, Housing, Transportation).

Candidates must commit to three years or 36 months of work at PCMC, following completion of MA program. Failure to fulfill work commitment will render sponsorship repayment due in prorated amounts based on number of work months completed at PCMC.

Sponsorship Amount

\$10,000

\$10,000 is the max sponsorship amount PCMC will pay out per candidate’s educational expenses. Scholarship amounts may vary depending on PCMC needs, cost of tuition, or the discretion of PCMC workforce development committee.
